Update from Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari on Pedestrian Struck at Lincoln Park in Jersey City

JERSEY CITY, NJ – Update from Hudson County Sheriff Frank X. Schillari regarding a pedestrian struck at Lincoln Park in Jersey City this morning.

"This morning, a pedestrian was struck as he walked on the bridge that goes over route 1&9 at Lincoln Park in Jersey City," said Sheriff Schillari. "Stanley Mis, 65, of Jersey City, was struck by a dark green 2003 GMC Envoy, that jumped the curb. The vehicle then fled the scene.

The victim needed to receive CPR at the scene by Jersey City EMS and was transported by them to the Jersey City Medical Center, where he remains in very critical condition.

During an intense manhunt, a Sheriff's Patrol Officer found the suspected vehicle parked on Belmont Ave. near Bergen Ave., with damage to the windshield and passenger side.

The Hudson County Sheriff's Office Crash Investigation Unit are actively investigating the accident and looking for the driver of the vehicle."
